

A range of issues have been raised by interested and affected stakeholders through the consultation process undertaken to date. The date, method of contact, and proponent responses are presented in this Appendix. The methods of consultation are abbreviated as present in the table below.

Stakeholder meetings have occurred through the EIS process. Depending on the stakeholder, consultation has been either ongoing or occurring at key stages during the EIS process.

Other stakeholders have been invited to attend and participate in stakeholder meetings and briefings at the following three stages during the EIS process:

- Consultation Round One (R1)- The first round of consultation commenced from October 2007, and coincided with the release of the draft TOR. It had the objective of informing stakeholders and the community about the project, and the first round of comments and issues were collected to inform the early development of the environmental studies.
- Consultation Round Two (R2)- The second round of consultation commenced from July 2008, and was focused on providing an update on the description of the project, the status of the EIS, and gathering information relevant for the socio-economic impact assessment.
- Consultation Round Three (R3)- The third round of consultation occurred from October 2008, and focused on providing an update on the description of the project, and gathering information to feed into the socio-economic impact assessment.
